The pointed pen is so versatile - we can go from thick to thin lines, various lettering styles, mark-making, floral painting in one swoop with this little jewel . I just love this pen! We will be taking a look at the traditional scripts that this lovely tool can do easily, then push the envelope a bit more and leap into new adventures. Baby steps with lots of exercises with guidance, then more exciting pages as we progress. We'll give our lettering a little more "spice" for a fresh, contemporary look and have a final keepsake book to show for our efforts. Supplies to come. (some knowledge of Copperplate is helpful)

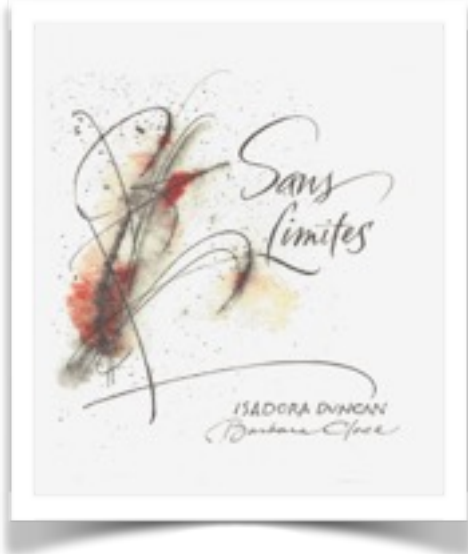
