Participants will learn how to make a 48-page book/journal using sophisticated book binding techniques. They will learn how to cover book boards and will be given instructions on how to make book cover jigs for precise cutting. The instructors will introduce participants to book binding tools and jigs that will make the process easy.

Participants will paint and decorate book spine strips which will be woven through the signature stitches. Decorative end papers will be added for a professional finished look to the book.

No previous bookbinding experience needed. Instructors will provide detailed instruction for each step of the book/journal construction. They will also share examples of alternate book designs that participants may want to explore on their own.
