

Folded and Decorated Journal Bookmaking Workshop

In this workshop you will learn basic bookmaking construction of a journal made with folded paper which you will decorate with mixed colors of acrylic paint or covered with decorative paper. You will learn how to fold pages and sew them into an accordion spine and finish with Japanese stab binding or decorative sewn binding and with either a magnet closure or button, bead, and thread closure.

You will leave with a completed journal for filling with your drawings or journaling or for presenting to someone as a beautiful gift.

- Bone or Teflon folder (or we will have used gift cards that can be used like a bone folder for crisp paper folds)
